Meta House ends the generational cycle of addiction by healing women and strengthening families.

Residential Treatment

Our most intensive treatment setting where women live alongside their children while receiving 24/7 comprehensive care

93% of the women who stayed in Residential treatment longer than 60 days were abstinent from or reduced their drug and alcohol use between admission and discharge.

Population Served:

424 women, 109 of whom were pregnant or postpartum & 242 children

Outpatient Treatment

A highly-individualized day treatment program for women in early recovery.

81% of women who stayed in outpatient treatment longer than 90 days were abstinent from alcohol and drugs. 69% of the women were employed, enrolled in a training program or had another legal source of income when they discharged from the program.

Length of Stay:

Meta Housing

A safe, affordable and substance-free transitional living community for women in early recovery and their children.

94% of women who stayed in the program at least six months:
- moved into permanent housing after leaving Meta Housing
- moved to a drug-free location
- maintained their reduced level of substance use
